Every Victim Matters Hate Crime Awareness Training

Stand Against Racism and Inequality is working with Compass Disability and the Diversity Trust across Somerset, North Somerset and Bath & North East Somerset on a 5-year Big Lottery funded project called Every Victim Matters. As part of this we are delivering hate crime awareness training to professionals and organisations across the area. The training is free for participants and is delivered by the partner organisations.

Workshops can be delivered at your workplace with groups of up to 20 participants. Briefing sessions with larger audiences can also be arranged. Please allow up to 3 hours for an interactive workshop and up to 2 hours for a briefing session.

Outcomes for previous delegates:

- Delegates of training sessions report that they have a greater understanding of the impact of hate crime
- Delegates report that they are more aware of best practice and available tools for tackling hate crime
- Delegates report that they know more about the sources of specialist support locally
- Delegates report they feel confident to share their knowledge with colleagues
