

## **Privacy Policy Statement**

The Diversity Trust CIC is a "data controller" for the purposes of the Data Protection Act (1998) and the EU General Data Protection Regulation (2016/679), known as GDPR.

This means that we are responsible for, and control the processing, of your personal information. Below are your rights under this law, and how you can use them.

**Right to be informed**: We must provide you with a privacy notice to tell you how we are using your personal data, why we are using it and how long we are likely to use it for. Right of access: You can ask us for access to any of the information we hold on you at any time by filling out a "SUBJECT ACCESS REQUEST FORM" available by emailing <a href="mailto:info@diversitytrust.org.uk">info@diversitytrust.org.uk</a> or by calling 0844 800 4425 or by writing to PO Box 5189, Somerset BA6 0BN. Information will be given to you within one month of your request being received.

**Right to rectification**: you can change your personal data if it is inaccurate or incomplete. Please contact us if any of your personal information changes.

**Right to erasure**: you can ask us to delete or remove your personal data where there is no reason for us to keep it. Contact <a href="mailto:info@diversitytrust.org.uk">info@diversitytrust.org.uk</a> to request this.

**Right to restrict data processing**: Under certain circumstances, you can 'block' us from using your personal data. We are then allowed to store your personal data, but nothing more.

**Right to complain**: You have the right to complain to a supervisory body (<u>Information Commissioners Office</u>) if you feel



we have failed to meet our duties to you in any way in relation to your personal data.
