

Spotlight on... World Diversity Day, 21 May



World Diversity Day is sanctioned by United Nations for the promotion of diversity issues. It is currently celebrated on May 21st.

According to PWC's <u>2020 Global Diversity & Inclusion Survey</u>, 33% of companies still view diversity as a barrier in their organisation. The lack of diversity within marketing, advertising and design has revealed a genuine problem; and the greater the impact we can have on expanding this conversation, the more awareness raised and action we can all take on improving diversity and inclusion across our industries.

DT partnered with distillery, award-winning content studio, to promote The Diversity Type Project, which aimed to do exactly that.

Phase 1 of the project succeeded in getting the conversation started! It was supported by 308 people, across 54 different countries, and helped to create a typeface that celebrates diversity. This was released for sale on World Diversity Day to raise funds to support the Diversity Trust, the <u>Disasters Emergency Committee</u> and <u>UN Women</u>.


