Course Overview

This one-day course is aimed at those working across the corporate, public, voluntary and community sectors. It is aimed at practitioners and managers working with children and young people. The course includes an overview of equalities and safeguarding legislation and analysis of sexual orientation and gender identity, in relation to safeguarding children, young people and families.
